10 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FY 2020-21 BUDGET BY APPROPRIATING \$22,239 IN
11 FEDERAL PASS-THROUGH GRANT FUNDING TO THE CAPITAL PROJECTS FUND FOR
12 THE GROWDEN AREA ACCESSIBILITY IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT FOR THE PURPOSE
13 OF PROVIDING PARKS AND RECREATION PROJECT SUPPORT, DESIGNING AND
14 FURNISHING INTERPRETIVE PANELS, AND PROVIDING DESIGN SUPPORT FOR
15 WAYFINDING SIGNS

17 WHEREAS, The Federal Highways Administration (FHWA), through the
18 Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (AKDOT&PF), has selected the
19 Growden Area Accessibility Improvements Project for the Alaska Transportation
20 Alternatives Program (ATAP) award; and
21

22 WHEREAS, The Fairbanks North Star Borough (Borough) Assembly adopted
23 ordinance No. 2019-20-1B, which appropriated funds for the Growden Area Accessibility
24 Improvements Project; and
25

26 WHEREAS, This project is currently under agreement between the Borough
27 and AKDOT&PF; and
28

29 WHEREAS, AKDOT&PF will manage and design the project with FHWA funds
30 and previously appropriated matching funds from the Borough; and
31

32 WHEREAS, The Borough Department of Parks and Recreation (Parks &
33 Recreation) will provide support to the AKDOT&PF design and construction team and
34 ensure the project receives necessary Borough coordination and review; and
35

36 WHEREAS, Parks & Recreation's role on this project includes design support
37 of wayfinding sign panels, designing and furnishing interpretive panels, and providing
38 support during the project's construction.

40 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Assembly of the Fairbanks
41 North Star Borough:
42

43 Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is not of a general and permanent
44 nature and shall not be codified.

45 Section 2. Acceptance of Federal Pass-Through Grant Funding. The
46 Borough accepts the award of \$22,239 in federal pass-through grant funding from FHWA,
47 passed through AKDOT&PF, to support project coordination and facilitate the design and
48 procurement of park signage on the Growden Area Accessibility Improvements project.
49

50 Section 3. Capital Projects Fund Appropriation. The FY 2020-21 budget is
51 hereby amended by appropriating \$22,239 to the Capital Projects Fund budgetary
52 guideline entitled "Growden Area Accessibility Improvements-Project Support and Park
53 Signage" and increasing estimated revenue from federal pass-through grants by a like
54 amount.
55

56 Section 4. Indirect Fee Waiver. In accordance with the signed
57 Memorandum of Agreement (MOA), indirect is waived for this appropriation.
58

59 Section 5. Eligible Expenditure Period. Expenditures incurred within the
60 effective dates of the signed MOA between AKDOT&PF and the Borough are eligible for
61 reimbursement.
62

63 Section 6. Provision for Appropriation Estimate. This appropriation is for
64 an estimated amount. The actual amount will be appropriated contingent, and based,
65 upon the signed MOA between ADOT&PF and the Borough. Any material difference, as
66 determined by the Chief Financial Officer, will be communicated to the Assembly.
67

68 Section 7. Contingency. This appropriation is contingent upon the receipt
69 of a signed MOA with AKDOT&PF.

71 Section 8. Effective Date. This ordinance is effective at 5:00 p.m. on the
72 first Borough business day following its adoption.
