9 A RESOLUTION APPROVING CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED COMMUNITIES AND THEIR
10 RESPECTIVE INCORPORATED NONPROFIT ENTITY/ENTITIES FOR PARTICIPATION IN
11 THE FY 2021-22 COMMUNITY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

13 WHEREAS, AS 29.60.865 and 3 AAC 180.010 require the assembly of a
14 borough to adopt a resolution identifying those unincorporated communities located
15 within their municipal boundaries that the assembly determines meet the Community
16 Assistance Program eligibility criteria established under AS 29.60.865, AS 29.60.879, and
17 3 AAC 180.110; and
18

19 WHEREAS, The unincorporated community has an incorporated nonprofit
20 entity that will agree to receive and spend the Community Assistance payment for the
21 public benefit of the unincorporated community; and
22

23 WHEREAS, The unincorporated community has 25 or more residents
24 residing as a social unit; and
25

26 WHEREAS, At least three of the following services: fire protection,
27 emergency medical, water and sewer, solid waste management, public road or ice road
28 maintenance, public health, and search and rescue, are generally available to all residents
29 of the unincorporated community; and, each of the three services, in any combination,
30 are provided by one or more qualifying incorporated nonprofit entities or are substantially
31 paid for by the residents of the unincorporated community through taxes, charges, or
32 assessments levied or authorized by the Borough.

34 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Assembly of the Fairbanks
35 North Star Borough:

37 Section 1. Certification. The Fairbanks North Star Borough Assembly, by
38 this resolution, hereby certifies that the following unincorporated communities and their
39 respective incorporated nonprofit entity/entities are eligible for funding under the FY
40 2021-2022 Community Assistance Program:
